<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of the <i>Shibo Todoke no Kisai Kijo Shomeisho</i> with an English translation and duly Apostilled by the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Gaimusho)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Original cremation permit (Kaso Kyokasho) issued by the City Hall or Ward Office with an English translation and Apostilled by the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Gaimusho)
